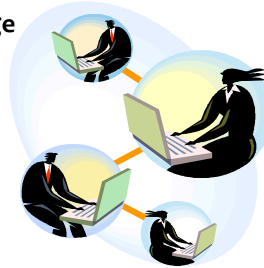


Diploma of International Business Starts in 19 Jan 2009 (Available in Brisbane Campus)

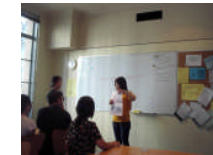


- Entry requirements: PG Upper-intermediate, advanced and advanced-plus levels (IELTS 5.5, TOEIC 650 with minimum reading score of 350 or pre test is also available)
- Course duration: 20weeks(including Internship for Diploma of International Business & import project for Cert IV International Trade)/17weeks(working holiday visa)
- 2009 starting dates: 19 Jan,16 Mar, 5 May, 9 June, 3 Aug (Diploma of International Business)/2 Feb & 20 July (Cert IV International Trade)
- Fees : Tuition \$5,220(Opening special fee for Diploma of International business)/\$5,500(Cert IV International Trade), Application Fee \$200, Material Fee \$280
